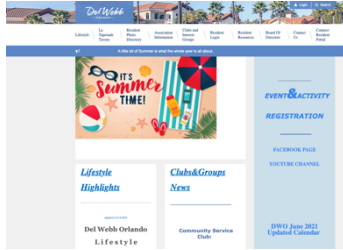


Did You Know...



In February, the Board of Directors formed a project team with representatives from the Technology, Finance and Communications committees to look at replacing the current DWO website. Our vibrant community offers many activities, clubs and events to support the active lifestyle that drew us to Del Webb Orlando and our residents and staff want an easy to use website to keep us informed and connected. Our current “DWO portal” was launched over 10 years ago and does not offer the features and ease of use needed to keep us up to date on all the activities in our community. Whether you want information on what’s happening today at the clubhouse, need to register for a lifestyle event or just want to find the recent board of directors or community manager’s updates, our DWO website should be the place to go for quick and easy access to what you need when you need it!

Since March, the team has been busy gathering community feedback and understanding the features and limitations of our current website. The team also talked to residents of other 55 plus communities to learn about what software they use and their experiences with the websites and vendor support.

Armed with that information, the team set out to find new website solutions that provide comprehensive communications, lifestyle and club support and can be easily used on computers, smart phones and mobile devices. HOA software solutions were researched and several companies were selected to demo their offerings and discuss their capabilities and support.

The team is working to finalize a website tool recommendation to the Board of Directors at their July Board meeting. Once the tool is approved then the team will begin working on the implementation of a new website. In support of this effort, there will be surveys conducted to get resident input for our new website.
